

OLD BRIDGE BEACH RECREATION AREA



Old Bridge Beach is a U.S. fee area operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Currently the fee is \$4.00 per vehicle up to eight persons. Old Bridge Beach is located on the southwest side of Bay Springs Lake just off of MS Highway 4 and Prentiss County Road 3501. It contains a playground area, fishing pier, restroom, two large covered shelters, other single uncovered picnic tables with grills, outdoors shower, volleyball court, and a white sand beach.
